BEFORE SCHOOL

We have seen an increase in behaviors that cause concern for safety in the process of drop-offs.

- **DO NOT drop students off to the school before 8:15am.** --Students are unsupervised.

We ask that parents/guardians please do not crowd near the front doors to the school instead, wait by their students grade level tree.

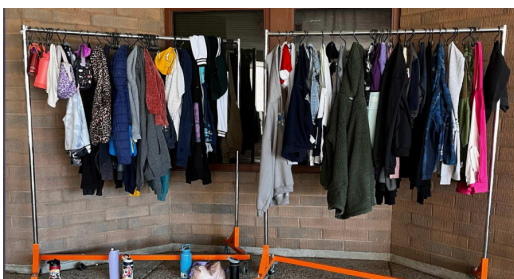
Additionally, please remember that for the safety of everyone, pets are not allowed on the Otondo campus without prior approval. This includes before school drop off and after school pick up.
